

PLAYA LAGUN



Just around the corner from Mushroom Forest, this excellent dive site hosts mushroom-like hard coral formations on the reef and all sorts of cool marine life on the shallow, sandy swim-out from one of the island's few natural sand beaches.

Easy but pretty long swim out to the reef - so do it underwater! But a heads-up: the sandy, shallow swim out is home to so many cool critters that you may not actually get to the gently sloping wall, filled with hard and soft corals and plenty of marine life.

Look out for seahorses and a huge variety of reef fish on the swim out, spotted eagle rays in the vast, white sandy areas and the usual suspects out on the reef itself.

Remember to look up for turtles hanging out on the surface - they nest on a protected corner of the beach.

JOURNEY TIME

45 mins from The Dive Bus

SHORE ENTRY

One of the easiest on the island - just walk in from the sandy beach, between the fishermen's boats. Please respect them: they were here long before us!

FACILITIES

Shade on the beach, beach cafe, parking.

NON-DIVERS

Nice beach with shade to hang out out, excellent, easy snorkeling just a few steps away - particularly around the edges of the cove, and a really beautiful view...
